This course follows NHTSA (National Highway Traffic Safety Administration) standards for Emergency Medical Responders. This 40-hour course covers topics such as Airway, Patient Assessment, Medical, Trauma, Special Patient Populations and EMS Operations. Provides the student with core knowledge and skills to function in the capacity of a first responder arriving at the scene of an emergency, providing supportive care until advanced EMS help arrives. Upon successful completion of the class, students may take the Colorado State Test and become a certified Emergency Medical Responder with the State of Colorado.
