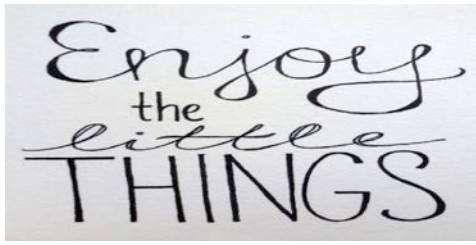

GED

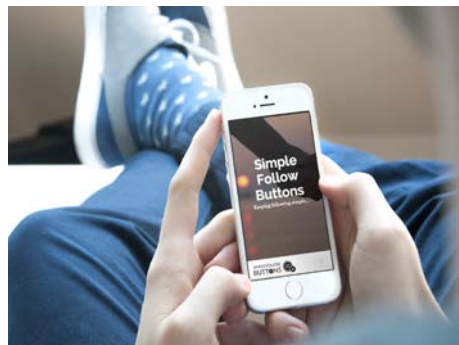
GED PREPARATION
