

How to Apply for Financial Aid at CNCC

- Apply for Admission to CNCC** – Online at www.cncc.edu – click on “Apply Start Here”.
- Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**
 - ✓ Submit the FAFSA online at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
 - ✓ If you do not already have an FSA ID, you can create one here: <https://fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index.htm>
 - ✓ Federal School Code for CNCC is **001359** (CNCC Rangely CO is correct for both campuses)
 - *FAFSA Tips: FAFSA uses prior tax year information, example 2021-2022 FAFSA requires 2019 tax information. Have the forms close by for reference.
 - ✓ Within 1 week of submitting your FAFSA you will receive a Student Aid Report (SAR) in your email. Review the information for accuracy.
 - ✓ If your SAR states that you have been selected for “federal verification”, the Financial Aid office will notify you of what documents are needed. In most cases copies of your tax return transcript for two years prior will be needed (obtained from IRS Only) as well as a completed copy of the Federal Verification Worksheet (this will be provided by the Financial Aid office, or available in Crossroads).
- CNCC Scholarship Application** (Including high school transcript) this can be found on our website here: <https://www.cncc.edu/admissions/scholarship-central>
- Await notification from the Financial Aid office.**
 - ✓ The FAFSA processor will send us your information electronically. We will review your FAFSA data, and if necessary, request additional documentation to verify your information.
 - ✓ Once we have received and evaluated all documentation, we will notify you of your financial aid award by sending you an award letter to your campus email account. This will include information on how to apply for student loans.
- Although not financial aid, all **Colorado Residents** should be sure that they have registered with the **College Opportunity Fund** to use their tuition assistance stipend.
