- **Face Coverings:** CNCC does not plan to require masks for Fall 2022; however, CNCC will comply with state and local requirements. Don't forget your mask, just in case! You are welcome to use a face covering.
- **COVID Vaccination:** Students are not required to have been vaccinated against COVID-19 to attend.
- **COVID Testing:** All students who were living in the residence halls are required to take a COVID test upon checking in. Any COVID+ detected must comply with CDC isolation and quarantine stipulations.
- **Assess Your Health:** Prior to coming to campus and throughout the year, we rely on you to continually assess your health and do what is best for yourself and others. If you are ill do not attend classes, practices, etc. Remember to contact your instructors.

Athletic's COVID Travel Protocol

CNCC's Athletic Director will check the COVID Alert Status of CNCC Counties and the Counties to which our student athletes will be traveling 48 hours prior to the departure date. Based on the criteria below, the Athletic Director will notify VP of Student Services of COVID testing needs (prior to travel or following) and will coordinate with the student services department for the test administration.

We will comply with the COVID Alert Status of the counties in which CNCC operates:

- If the county hosting an athletic team is in RED status (meaning an area of high transmission for the COVID virus) then our student athletes will be required to take a COVID test prior to traveling. Any COVID+ detected must comply with CDC isolation and quarantine stipulations and will not travel.
- If the county hosting an athletic team is GREEN, YELLOW, or ORANGE, then CNCC student athletes will not be tested and may travel for games.
- If the county to which a CNCC athletic team is traveling is RED status (meaning an area of high transmission for the COVID virus) then our student athletes will be required to take a COVID test upon returning. Any COVID+ detected must comply with CDC isolation and quarantine stipulations.
- If the county to which an athletic team is traveling is GREEN, YELLOW, or ORANGE, then CNCC student athletes may travel for games and will not be tested upon return.

Student Orientations: The purpose of orientation is to set you up for success in class and at our campus!
