

6.30 CHILDREN IN CNCC WORK AND CLASS ENVIRONMENT

Having children in the CNCC work and class environment raises issues concerning child safety, liability, and courtesy to other students and employees. CNCC premises are considered a professional work and learning environment. Having children in this environment is generally not appropriate and impedes employees and students in performing their duties.

The occasional short visit of a child to a parent or other employee or student and students bringing children on campus when they conduct other business at CNCC is completely acceptable.

Employees (including student employees) are not to bring children to work with them or keep children with them during their working hours. Likewise, students are not to bring children to class with them nor to the College Library except for brief periods for checking out materials, etc.

There are three exceptions to this policy:

1. College for Kids or other programs presented for children.
2. CNCC Housing staff's children in their parent's living quarters.
3. Athletic or other sponsored events that may include children.
